Please reschedule any dance, gymnastics, private lessons, and appointments. Students should not be involved in other camps that interfere with TeenzAct.

Daily dress: **NO FLIP FLOPS OR SANDALS**! Students will not be able to participate if they do not have the proper footwear. **NO BARE FEET**!!!
